MEMBERS RENEWING AFTER OCT. 31 will be granted a grace period due to postal tardiness and/or foreign mailings. Renewals not received by the NBS Secretary by December 31 will be dropped from the following year's membership list.

RENEWALS RECEIVED AFTER DEC. 31 will receive Bulletin(s) published 30 days or more AFTER the NBS Secretary receives their dues. (NOTE: late renewals may order missed Bulletin(s), Classification and/or Directory, by including \$2 postage per item with dues.)

NEW MEMBERS JOINING AFTER AUG. 1 will be enrolled for the following year and will receive Bulletins published 30 days or more after dues are received by the NBS Secretary. (Example: If you join at the NBS Convention in August, you will receive the Oct. and Dec. Bulletins of that same year and all the next year's Bulletins.) New members joining between January 1– July 31 will receive missed Bulletin(s), if available, or an equivalent number of Bulletin(s) from a prior year.

THE NATIONAL BUTTON SOCIETY, organized in 1939, is a nonprofit organization devoted to the promotion of the hobby of collecting clothing buttons. The organization is open to all collectors, members of the button trade, museums, libraries, and others who find buttons of particular interest.

Members receive 5 issues of the National Button Society Bulletin (mailed in early Feb., May, July, Oct. & Dec.), the Official Classification System booklet (included with Feb. Bulletin every 5 years), and a Membership Directory (included with July Bulletin in odd years).
